YUMMY RECIPES!

Chocolate Drop Cookies

Ingredients:

1 cup margarine	1 tsp. baking soda
2 cups brown sugar	1-1/2 cup milk
2 eggs	8 T. baking cocoa
4 cups flour	2 tsp. vanilla
1 tsp. salt	1-1/2 cup nuts

Cream margarine and sugar. Add beaten eggs. Add flour, salt, soda, and cocoa, add alternately with milk. Add nuts and vanilla. Drop by spoonful on a greased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for about 8 minutes.

Frosting:

6 T. milk	1 cup chocolate chips
6 T. butter	1 tsp. vanilla

1-1/2 cup powdered sugar

Bring to a boil for 1 minute. Add chocolate chips and vanilla.

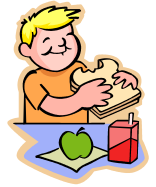
