Renville County Fire Emergency & Burn Ban Policy Approved

Lack of moisture in the area has greatly increased the fire danger. Combination of wind and the lack of moisture has dried vegetation that promotes large fire growth. All area fire departments have responded to numerous fire calls including many large grass fires. In several of the fire calls mutual aid from other fire departments has been requested. The Renville County Commissioners have approved the following Fire Emergency & Burn Ban Policy for Renville County. If you have any questions, please contact your local fire department or Kristy Titus, Renville County Emergency Manager at 756-6288. An Automatic Burn Ban (including a ban on the ignition of fireworks, garbage burning, and campfires) will remain in effect whenever the National Weather Service fire index is in the Very High or Extreme Status and/or a Red Flag Warning has been issued for Renville County. This policy will remain in effect until further notice. Any individual who willfully violates this Burn Ban is guilty of a Class B Misdemeanor (up to 30 days in jail and a \$1,000.00 fine).
